Who Can Borrow from the Library?

- Individuals with a disability
- Anyone trying to accommodate an individual with a disability.
- Professionals (counselors, schools, prospective employers, etc.)
- ALMOST ANYONE

What is the Cost and Length of a Device Loan?

- All loans are completely **FREE**
- Device loans are about four weeks long, but can be extended depending on circumstances.
