Accessible

Accessible playgrounds in Orange County are the ones that allow children to enter onto the actual play structures via a ramp that provides accesses to slides and other play areas "up high" off the ground.

Sand Free

Sand free parks do not have sand or bark surfacing - only recycled rubber. This provides wheelchair access to the equipment, although no ability to actually reach the upper levels of the equipment.
