## CREATE A WORK FROM HOME ENVIRONMENT FOR YOUR CTE CLASSES

Learning from home has significant parallels to working from home (WFH), and in CTE we can help build WFH skills along side industry as a way to set class norms. Have students <u>research work-from home strategies</u> and watch <u>videos about working from home</u> to determine the norms, routines and guidelines that might work best for them. They can then use a free design program like <u>Canva</u> to put together their own "Work From Home" infographic that might look something as simple as is shown the article above or more complex like this fun <u>Work From Home Infographic</u>.
