



CALIFORNIA CAREER INNOVATIONS (CCi) INTERVENTIONS CHART

CCi GOAL: Increased economic self-sufficiency, through planned education, work-based learning experiences, and Competitive Integrated Employment for students with disabilities (Updated 3-19-18)

RSA GOALS:

- #1: All project participants will successfully complete at least 2 work-based learning (WBL) experiences including one paid work experience.
- #2: Participation in the project demonstrates the WBL experiences have contributed to the participants academic & career planning
- #3: Project Participants enroll in PSE or Training
- #4: Project Participants obtain competitive integrated employment (CIE), including supported employment

RSA Performance Measure:

- #1: The percentage of all participants who successfully complete at least 2 WBL experiences, including one paid work experience
- #2: The percentage of participants who demonstrate a significant improvement in the knowledge & skills needed to effectively engage in academic & career planning
- #3: The percentage of all participants who enroll in an education or training program that leads to a recognized postsecondary credential either while in the program or within 1 year of participant's completion
- #4: The difference in percentage points between the percentage of participants in the Transition Work-Based Learning Model Demonstration who enroll in an education or training program that leads to a recognized postsecondary credential either while in the program or within one year of completing the program compared to the percentage of comparable group of students with disabilities not in the program who enroll in an education or training program that leads to a recognized postsecondary credential.*
**This performance measure is for programs with a control group. CCi will utilize a comparison group.*
- #5: The percentage of participants completing the program who obtained CIE, including supported employment within one year of completing the program; [or for participants who are still in secondary education one year after completing the program, the number who obtained CIE within one year of graduation from /or completion of secondary education].

CCi Objectives:

- 1) Implement demonstration project for at least 800 students with disabilities
- 2) 90% of students will participate in non-paid career focused internships
- 3) 75% of students will participate in paid career focused internships
- 4) 90% of students will participate in career pathway programs
- 5) 75% of students will participate in Post-Secondary Education (PSE) programs and/or Competitive Integrated Employment (CIE) for at least 20 hours per week
- 6) Implement 5-year research & demonstration protocol that assess formative, progress & outcome measures for student

CCi Interventions:

- 1) Basic Interventions: The basics are support services and resources that all CCi students will receive (if applicable).
- 2) Core Interventions: The core interventions are to be provided to all CCi students.
- 3) Research Interventions: The research interventions will be randomly assigned to CCi students.

The basics are support services and resources that all California Career Innovations (CCi) students will receive (if applicable) through a variety of means including: CCi Career Coaches, general education school program, charter school program, special education program, WorkAbility I, Transition Partnership Program, other DOR sponsored programs and community-based employment related service program.
