ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY EXCHANGE CENTER

Provides assistive technology services and solutions to individuals with disabilities of all ages, their families and employers

Key services:

COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES PROGRAM

DEAFINITELY PROFESSIONAL INTERPRETING SERVICES

Provides the Orange County Deaf community with American Sign Language interpreting services.

Most of the services are provided within Orange County; however, there are interpreters available to interpret in neighboring counties.

Services are provided in schools, businesses, and medical/legal offices
