	LBHS Transition Services consists of WorkAbility 1, Transitional Partnership Program (TPP) and Functional Unique Training Utilizing Resource Employment Society (FUTURES). Each program is designed to further the growth of the individual student.
	Our WorkAbility 1 program supports all students 14-22 years of age having an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) with marketable job skills, paid and unpaid work experience and on the job support. Students take part in a variety of assessments to determine vocational interests. Work placements are based on the aptitude and ability of the student by first conducting vocational assessments and then matching the student to the proper local business who provides the student with a hands on experience.
	The TPP program assists LBHS students with an IEP that are 16-22 years of age with Job Exploration, Workplace Readiness, Workplace Learning, Instruction in Self-Advocacy and Counseling on Post-Secondary Education. The program assists in developing the necessary skills for competitive integrated employment and student success.
	FUTURES program is available to special education students 18-22 years of age who have completed High School with a certificate of completion. FUTURES furthers the growth of independence through Employment Skills, Functional Academics, Mobility Training and Daily Living Skills.
