	<p>TPP- The N-MUSD TPP Student Services Program provides activities that support students, ages 16 through 21 with an IEP/504 plan, transition to the world of work. Services are based on interests and may include: Helping students explore career options and find jobs that match their skills and interests. Preparing students for employment by developing good work habits and appropriate social practices. Building confidence and leadership abilities in the workplace through self-advocacy instruction. Offering paid and unpaid work experience opportunities in local professional settings</p> <p>WorkAbility is a California school and community program designed to benefit students, employers and the community by promoting career awareness, preparation and exploration for our transition age youth in secondary education programs. WorkAbility helps students develop positive interpersonal skills and marketable job skills. WorkAbility may provide opportunities for paid work experience, limited term on-the-job support and guidance from our WorkAbility personnel.</p>

	STEP N-MUSD Adult Transition Program's five classrooms directed by highly qualified teachers provide a variety of instruction, community and volunteer work-based training experiences for our students 18-22 years old that have not received a high school diploma. Each student's program is developed to meet their unique needs and desired student outcomes. Program may offer: Self-advocacy, develop organizational skills, improve life skills, community safety, travel training, prevocational skills, job specific skills training and link with adult service providers, supported employment or independent employment.
