Summary	
	The purpose of this program is to develop skills that advance employment opportunities, provide pathways to careers, and promote participants to succeed as contributing members of their community. The program requires that selected individuals and their family commit to competitive integrated employment, at the conclusion of the training program. This is a 30 hours per week, specialized non- paid internship training program, that runs for a maximum of 11 months. The weekly schedule is Monday-Friday, from 9 AM to 3:00 PM. Selected individuals may participate in up to 4 internship rotations, which may take place in up to 4 different departments within the host business site. Each rotation is 10 weeks long, with one week for review and preparation between rotations. Selected individuals must be willing to take public or para-transit transportation. Selected individuals must enroll in at least one employability related OC community college/continuing education course through the program's education partner (class to be provided at program site during program hours).
