	Driven by participant's goals identified in the Individualized Transition Plan (ITP), the Adult Transition Program (ATP) provides participants an opportunity to explore/participate in: post-secondary education (community college, vocational schools (ROP), etc.), post-secondary employment instruction and training (unpaid internships, resume prep, interviews, applications, etc.) as well as Independent/Life Skills instruction (exploration of independent living options, budget, cooking, laundry, etc.) ATP encourages participants to learn appropriate personal, social and work behaviors necessary for employment and independence. Goal is for participants to gain confidence to take risks, make their own decisions, take personal responsibility for their own actions, and gain knowledge of their rights as individuals.
