- Identifying any form of workplace harassment and discrimination
- Reducing or preventing incidents of misconduct
- Identifying the difference between legal discrimination and an illegal "hostile environment"

Effective January 1, 2019, California businesses with 5 or more employees MUST provide harassment prevention training every two years (SB1343). Regardless of what language you provide the training, it must be conducted every two years, so if you trained your team in 2019, 2021 is your training year. New employees must be trained within six (6) months of hire.
