





Education Jobs by Ownership<sup>5</sup>

Large seasonal employment fluctuations in public and private education are common. This is due mainly to the recurrent employment activities that follow the academic calendar. The magnitude of these fluctuations will differ based on the type of educational institution (i.e. local schools vs state and private universities). The line graph above shows that when schools close for the summer, educational employment levels drop, then recover as school reconvenes every autumn. There tends to be a small decrease in school employment during winter as well. Notice that during the pandemic the school cycle did not discontinue, but rather employment dropped at a steeper level. Even during the pandemic seasonal fluctuations did not subside. The chart to the left explores annual average employment by the share of jobs based on public or private ownership.
