

What You Need to Know

Your Role:

 Dental Sterilization Technicians clean, sterilize, and assemble surgical instruments, equipment, and supplies for use in operating rooms and other medical and surgical facilities. Includes responsibility for sterilization; infection control; decontamination; and surgical instrumentation processing, distribution, and record-keeping.

On the job, you will:

- Prepare patient, sterilize or disinfect instruments and workspaces, set up instrument trays, prepare materials
- Clean instruments to prepare them for sterilization.
- Record sterilizer test results.
- Monitor instrument stock levels and assist in ordering after the 'record sterilizer test results
