About The Higher Education Mentoring Program

The Higher Education Mentoring Program is a six-year program that provides Latino high school students from Santa Ana with the academic, social and financial support needed to graduate from high school and succeed in college.

Our students enter the program at the beginning of their junior year of high school.

They are immediately matched with a university student or young professional mentor, which gives them the unique experience of exploring the world of higher education through the eyes of their mentor.





DUTIES

As a mentor, you'll be provided with training and support. You'll meet with your assigned student for 2-4 hours per month. You'll also work together with our program coordinators to help students research colleges and majors, and to complete scholarship and financial aid applications.

Mentors are a key part of the success. They are the voice of encouragement that tells our students "If I can do it, you can do it!" By generoursly volunteering your time, mentors gain valuable leadership experience and make lasting connections, all while giving back to their community.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a college graduate, working professional, or current university student
- Must be able to committ 2-4 hours per month
- Must be able to make a one-year commitment to mentoring your student (two years preferable)
